What documentation is acceptable to verify OCCUPANCY?

Proof of occupancy as a principal residence does not depend on any particular fact, but on whether all the facts and circumstances taken together tend to establish that the property was occupied by the person asserting eligibility for the PRE. Documents should be for the years of the audit that you owned the property. Generally, documentation demonstrating occupancy may include:

- A. Both sides of a driver's license with the property address
- B. Federal and/or State Income Tax returns with the property address
- C. A voter's registration record
- D. Motor vehicle registration or insurance
- E. Utility bills with the mailing address of the property
- F. Cable bills with the mailing address of the property
- G. Telephone bills with the mailing address of the property.
